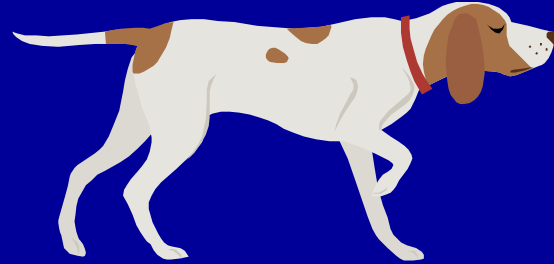


NOUNS

person, place or thing.

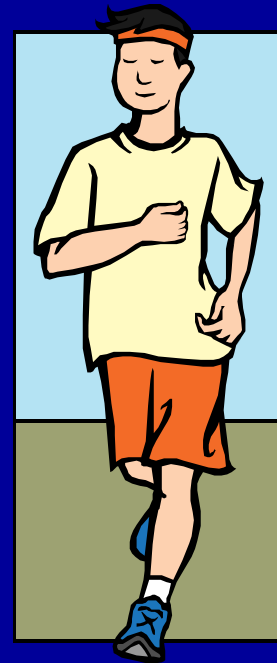
The dog followed the boy.

Which word is a noun?

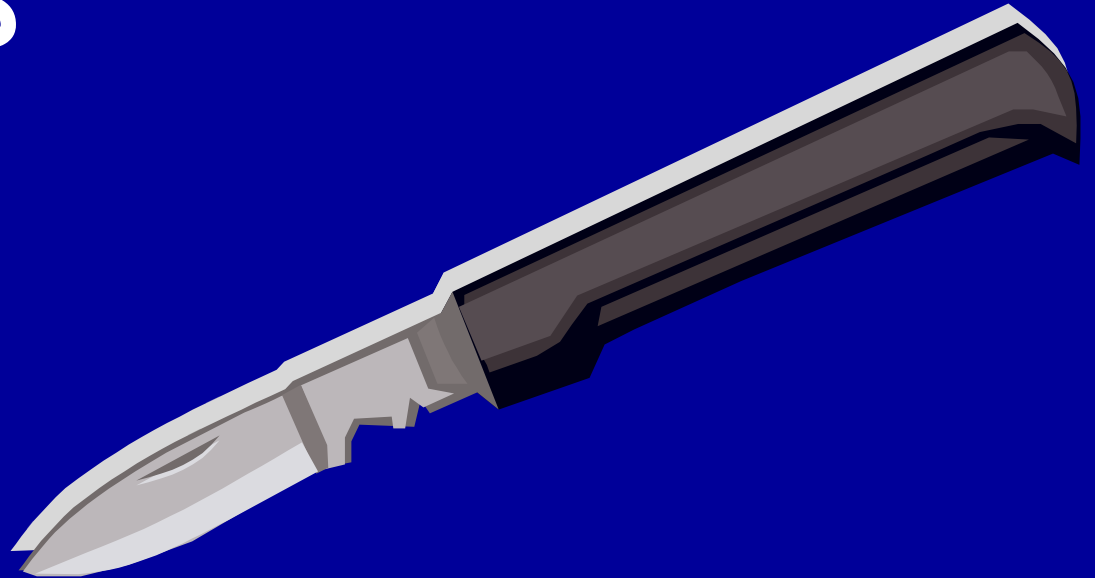
Yes it's
